Did you know 90% of brain development happens between birth and age three?
Help Me Grow services are for families who are pregnant or have children ages birth to three years. We help children stay on track and help parents get services the family may need.

Home Visits

Help Me Grow offers prenatal and on-going home visits for families with children under three. Home visits include:

- ◆ Providing information on your child's growth and development, including screenings to be sure he or she is on track
- ◆ Offering parenting tips
- ◆ Helping develop and reach family goals
- ◆ Early learning ideas
- ◆ Linking parents to community resources



Specialized Services

Sometimes young children need extra help because of a developmental concern or disability. Help Me Grow provides:

- ◆ A comprehensive developmental evaluation at no cost to families
- ◆ Referrals to on-going services for special needs like therapy and equipment



Service Connection

All families receive:

- ◆ Service coordination
- ◆ Family support groups and activities
- ◆ Help with your child's transition to Preschool and an IEP if necessary
- ◆ The chance to join a playgroup where your child will learn new things and play with other children

Newborn Home Visit

A registered nurse can visit your home shortly after you leave the hospital to give you information that might be helpful with your new baby. The visit will include:

- ◆ Reviewing your baby's health as well as mom's
- ◆ Sharing parent and resource information
- ◆ Answering any questions you may have
