* An asset-based student assistance AND workforce development program focused on helping students achieve their full potential.

* A collaborative effort between schools and the local community to assist in-school and out-of-school youth.

Transitions Plus is ...

* Designed to assist youth in successfully transitioning to self-sufficient adults.

* Serves every Wayne County Junior and Senior High School.



1. Student Assistance

- * Designed to help students become more successful in school.
- * Assists with organizational skills, study skills, and dropout prevention strategies.
- * Connects students and families to available school and community resources.
- * Encourages students to make positive decisions.

2. Employability Training

- * Designed to help students learn essential job skills.

Requirements:

- * 14 through 21 year-old youth.

- * Family income-based.
- * 12-month participation commitment.

WIA Youth Services include:

- * Paid and unpaid work experience
- * Supportive services
- * Comprehensive guidance and counseling
- * Tutoring and study skills
- * Drop-out prevention
- * Referrals to alternative secondary schools
- * Occupational skills training
- * Leadership development
- * Adult mentoring
- * Summer employment opportunity
- * Follow-up services

Participating Worksites:

- * Provide a safe environment and supervision under which the students can learn job skills.

- * Communicate periodically with the Transitions Coordinator (caseworker) about student performance.

- * Maintain students' timesheets at the worksite.

- * Complete a student work performance evaluation.
